They helped provide 50% off tutoring sessions through 8 months of the school year.

Students ranged from 2nd to 8th grade and sessions covered many areas of literacy and math.

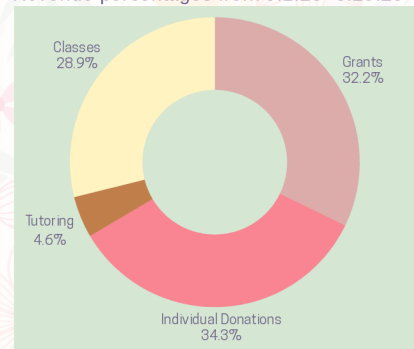
Both were a wonderful success!
