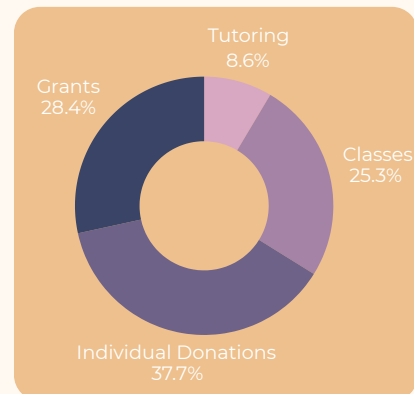
IONE:
